

A new trade union is born

The 1st of January 2008 the new Swedish trade union Unionen begins its work. Unionen is the result of a merger between two Swedish trade unions for white collar workers, Sif and HTF.

Unionen has approximately half a million members. It is the biggest Swedish union for white collar workers, with members in 66 000 workplaces. It covers almost all branches within the industrial and service sector in Sweden.
